The access to the information is allowed for the same, who has the right to update or correct the data.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING PRINTED MODEL 2
(2nd article of the NL)

- ▶ **The printed must be filled in Portuguese, no emendation or erasure, in block capital letters, and writing only one letter in each rectangle, leaving one blank between every word.**
- ▶ **This Model is composed of two pages that must be printed in a single sheet (front and back) for the safekeeping of the identification or recognition of the signature**
- ▶ **The printed must be signed by the representatives of the minor or legally incompetent or by a proxy with the special permission to do so.**
- ▶ **While filling, the declarant must sign intended options with an "x".**
- ▶ **In case the space provided is insufficient for each statement, a new print of the same model must be used, filling, only in the respective statement, the missing elements. In this case, both prints must be annexed.**
- ▶ **This print is available at: <http://www.irm.mj.pt> where other clarifications can also be procured.**

Box 1

1. The name must be the same as that of the document of identification or birth certificate, distinguishing between nickname and name.
2. Gender: F - female; M - male.
3. Identity document: passport, proof of address or another identity document, issued by the qualified authority of one of the countries from the European Union, which the interested subject wishes to enter.
4. Date in which the identification document was issued.
5. Authority who issued the identification document.
6. Filiation: must indicate the full name of the mother and father.
7. In the event of having resided in a foreign country, specify the respective locales of said country, if over 16 years old.
8. Profession must only be declared if over 16 years old.

Box 2

1. Presenting documents that prove this connection is allowed
2. Must only sign this statement, and enunciate about it, if the interested subject is over 16 years old.
3. Must only sign this statement, and enunciate about it, if the interested subject is over 16 years old.
4. Must only sign this statement, and enunciate about it, if the interested subject is over 16 years old.
5. The interested subject may sign this statement in the case that they possess the birth certificate, official copy, if possible, printed by photocopy; of the parent (mother or father) that has acquired Portuguese nationality.
6. In the event of not presenting the birth certificate of the mother or father that has acquired Portuguese nationality, the same can be obtained by the Services, the country of birth and filiation of the respective parent must be indicated.
7. If the minor or legally incompetent was born in Portugal and presents a birth certificate, the ladder being an official copy, if possible, printed by photocopy. In the event of not presenting said birth certificate, the Portuguese Central Registrations Service office where the same is filed must be indicated, so that the Services may acquire the document.
8. Must sign in case of wanting the criminal record to be acquired by the Services,

Box 3

1. Declaring phone number or e-mail is not obligatory.
2. The printed must be signed by the legal representatives of the minor or legally incompetent or by a proxy with the special permission to do so. The declarant must specify the conditions of intervening: as the legal representative, attorney of the mother, attorney of the father, or other condition.

Box 4

1. If born a foreigner, this document is mandatory. In this event, the birth certificate must be an official copy, printed by photocopy. This certificate must be legal, annexed with a translation if printed in a foreign language. If born in Portugal and presents birth certificate, this must be an official copy, if possible, printed by photocopy. In the event of not presenting birth certificate, statement 7 of box 2 must be filled if these elements are known, so that the Services may acquire the certificate.
2. Sign if the birth certificate of the Portuguese parent was presented. In the event of said certificate not being presented, the respective elements in statement 6 of box 2 must be filled, so that the Services may acquire the certificate.
3. This document must be annexed with a translation, in case of being printed in a foreign language. A certified copy of the passport can be presented
4. If the minor or legally incompetent is over 16 years old, must present criminal records certificate issued by the respective foreign country of birth, as well as the ones issued by countries where they may have resided after turning 16 years old, annexed with translations, in case of being printed in a foreign language (documents mandatory, unless an exemption for presentation is presented). The interested subject is exempt from presenting a Portuguese criminal record certificate, which may be officially procured by the Services; the statement 8 of box 2 must be filled.
5. If the minor or legally incompetent is over 16 years old, must present the documents that certify the nature of public functions exerted in foreign countries, in the event of signing "yes" in statement 3 of box 2.
6. If the minor or legally incompetent is over 16 years old, must present the documents that prove military service in a foreign

country, in the event of signing "yes" in statement 4 of box 2.

7. If there is interference by a proxy, the presentation of the Letter of Attorney is mandatory.

Box 5

1. The in person recognition can be made:

- Before a competent employee of the Services.
- In a Notary Office or a Central Registration Services office;
- In a foreign Portuguese consulate;
- By a lawyer or solicitor, or
- By commercial or industrial assemblies recognized by the terms in the decree -Law n° 244/92, of October 29th.

If the proxy is a lawyer or a solicitor, the presentation of their respective work permit, for the certification of the signature, is sufficient.

Box 6

1. Only checks issued by Portuguese banks are accepted.

2. In the money order, the name of the interested subject and the destiny of the order must always be mentioned.

The request may be rejected:

- a) If not printed in the model approved by the President of the Institute of Registries and Notaries (available at the extensions of the Central Registrations Services, in the Civil Registrations Services, Consulates and in the website: www.irm.mj.pt);
- b) If mentions or formalities specified by the printed are omitted;
- c) If the documents verifying the facts and statements that compose the foundations of the request are not presented.

If the request is terminally rejected, the declaration has no effects, **with no rights to a refund of any amount.**
